## KRRA SUBMISSION ITEMS

- 1. Restoration of the Connection Matarangi Kūaotunu full length walking and cycling access involving:
  - Suspension bridge across Bluff Cove and any necessary remedial work on the 6 slips that occurred in Cyclone Gabrielle

and including:

## **Road Safety improvements**

- Bluff Road to Quarry Point Boat ramp and onto Kingfisher Way on SH25 completion of the remaining sections of the footpath / cycleway
- 2. Road Safety improvements Footpath SH 25 Waitaia Road to the Village and speed management 50km/hr

(Both sections of footpath above were in the 2018-2028 LTP budget but have since been omitted in subsequent Annual Plans)

- 3. Dark Sky Status Kūaotunu Peninsula District Plan Change and implementation of revised lighting on a staged basis
- 4. Tennis Court Concrete Overlay Kūaotunu Domain allocation in Parks and Open Spaces budget
- 5. Boat Ramp Improvements Rock Revetment renewal
- 6. Kūaotunu West Gray Ave / Bluff Road Stormwater Culvert Pipe Dune Erosion Repair
- 7. Coastal Dune Care TCDC specific funding allocation for Kūaotunu for planting, resources and maintenance
- 8. Resilience investment into Sealing Whitianga Airfield potential co-fund with government Kanoa fund and Barrier Air

Public feedback will be sought March / April 2024, LTP 2024-2034 formal public submission hearings 1 & 2 May

- then potential changes - then to TCDC full Council 29 & 30 May and adoption 1 July 2024.
